Glenelg Catholic Parish Pastoral Council: Building a synodal missionary parish

I am the Chairperson for the Parish Pastoral Council. Fr John has asked me to write about the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) and what our goals are for the future. Some people may be asking, 'What is the Parish Pastoral Council?', and 'What do they do?'. The PPC is made up of the parish Priest Fr John, representatives from our 2 schools (OLOG and SMM), and 6-8 parishioners; we meet 10 times a year. Over the last year we have been asking ourselves the same questions outlined above, reflecting as a group upon the recommendations from the Diocesan Assembly, community and school input, direction from the Archdiocese, and asking ourselves the question 'What does a synodal parish on mission look and feel like?'. This reflection took place over a period of 9-12 months ultimately resulting in the development of a mission statement. Parish Pastoral Council Mission Statement: "We as parish intend to spread the word of Christ to others in a synodal manner through:

- Working with parishioners to continue to grow an active and participating community that is inclusive and welcoming to all
- Providing outreach opportunities for parishioners to help others in our community
- Working with schools and families to increase the engagement of children and young people in our Eucharistic community who love and care in the manner of Jesus.
- Helping people develop their faith by providing opportunities to explore and grow their friendship with God

Our intent is to focus the parishes missionary opportunities to target community, outreach, families, and faith development. Pope Francis has asked us to commit to 'Synodality' which means to 'journey together'. We as a council are calling upon you as people of God to work in synodality together and commit to these opportunities for mission. We understand that commitment can be overwhelming however please consider that commitment can be big or small, short term or long term, and opportunities are available to all.

This year we will begin looking for faith driven, motivated parishioners to join the PPC in 2025. Any parishioners who feel that they would like to be part of developing, coordinating and supporting strategies to achieve our mission statement goals are encouraged to approach myself, Fr John, any current members of the PPC, or the parish office to express their interest. There is no limitation on who can join the PPC and we encourage anyone to come forward. We at the PPC thank you for your commitment and contributions to our faith community and hope to speak to many of you in the coming months.
